At the time of my first visit to Ethiopia in 2010, Emmanuel United Church was comprised of approximately 140 local churches. As of December 2022, that number had increased to over 850. God is doing a powerful work there and we are blessed to be a small part of it. Unprecedented numbers of souls from many different tribes and religions are being granted entrance into the Kingdom of God, as Jesus' disciple making movement continues to spread across Ethiopia and way beyond. The need to equip and release leaders into the harvest continues to increase exponentially. Praise Jesus!

I am departing the U.S. this evening for ministry in Ethiopia and will return on Monday 27. I will be ministering in six separate locations throughout Ethiopia. Along with follow-up visits and next step training to some existing groups, we plan to move further eastward to establish much needed leadership group trainings as the influence of the Holy Spirit remains powerfully at work there. Our previous prayers for growth in this region are being answered and our preceding dreams are coming to fruition. Thank you again for uniting with us in prayer.

As the years go by, each trip becomes more physically demanding. I am now more than ever intensely aware of my dependance upon the Lord to give me strength, endurance and good health on these trips. I request your ongoing prayers that I may remain healthy and able to minister at full capacity throughout the entire trip.

 - Stabilize and provide for the ever-increasing cost of student support and travel due to globalized inflation.
 - Provide safe passage to and from training sites and protect their families and churches at home.
 - Direct and bless me in better understanding and practicing preventative travel sickness measures.

 - Bless me with good health, for great effectiveness in ministry and the ultimate glory of His Name.
