Dear Brothers, Sisters, Partners and Friends,

I write to give report of the 2019 mission in Africa and also to inform you of some exciting changes in the ministry.

2019 Mission Report:

Our influence and impact continue to increase both in Ethiopia and Kenya. In all we brought 5 Leadership Training events:

- 1. Addis Ababa, Ethiopia. 10, 2nd year students (pastors and movement leaders) participated in 2 day teaching: "The Church That Jesus is Building."
 - a. Life and ministry changing testimonies resulted.
- 2. Adama (formerly Nazareth) Ethiopia. 30 plus, 1st year students (college students, planters, pastors, various church ministry leaders from various denominations) engaged the 2 day training: "The Master's Plan."
 - a. Many more life and ministry changing testimonies resulted.
- 3. Adama (formerly Nazareth) Ethiopia. 10-15, 3rd year students (various leaders) partook in and contributed to the 2 day training: "Living the Life."
 - a. Testimonies were God honoring, speaking again of life and ministry altering results and many filled with heart-felt emotions.
- 4. Addis Ababa, Ethiopia. 18-20, 2nd year students (various levels of leaders) actively joined and shared in the 2 day training: "The Church That Jesus is Building."
 - a. Director of Theology for Emmanuel United Church of Ethiopia stated he would revise his doctrines of "church" and "salvation" as a result of the training. This will impact the entire E.U.C.E. movement throughout the whole country.
- 5. Nairobi, Kenya. 50 plus enthusiastic learners ranging from Bible Study teachers, pastors, movement leaders to a Dr. of Psychology contributed to and grew through a 3 day training entitled: "Interpreting the Scriptures Accurately."
 - a. Testimonies included statements like "powerful, Spirit-led and again, life and ministry changing!"

In 2020 we plan to repeat 4 trainings in 3-4 different venues in Ethiopia. For Nairobi, we will increase to 2, 3 day trainings. In each country we plan to cycle students through 6 trainings which will result in them receiving a certificate of completion.

Exciting Changes:

Our ministry in Africa which was formerly a sub-mission of Crossway Christian Church of Saco, Maine; is currently in the process of becoming a legally registered 501c3 non-profit organization known as *The Master's Mission International*.
