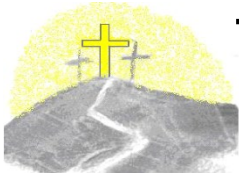

We are going to baptize 750 new converts by the end of next week.

I am in Adama now I just finished the meeting with our local leaders and church planters; majority of them are your students who understand the the Gospel, the kingdom of God, King Jesus, the church that Jesus's building e.t.c . I believe that your students laid a very good foundations in the lives of those who are read to get baptized by next week.

Pray for their safe journey as they are coming to the river, for their transportation and for their meals and a bottle of water as we trusting the Lord to provide them food and water because majority of them walking on their foot 2 to 3 hrs and will be get tired after baptism.

Also, please continue to pray for my next trip to Ethiopia briefly described below.

Upcoming Mission Trip:

Seven training/fellowship community events in seven different locations in Ethiopia, are confirmed for April 3rd through the 27th, 2024. We will focus on follow-up visits and next step training to the seven existing groups. Each of these groups are located in different strategic regions throughout Ethiopia and engage in a series of progressive exegetical Biblical studies (See TMMI Training Sequence below) designed to teach, implement and maintain Biblical Missiology, Biblical Ecclesiology and Biblical Spiritual Formation as taught by Master Jesus, His Apostles/disciples and the early church leaders.
