Dear Brothers and Sisters in Our Lord,

Thank you for the love many of you already have shown to your brothers and sisters in Ethiopia and Kenya as demonstrated by your ongoing prayers and financial support for me to return to Africa in order to continue leadership training we initiated in 2010.

As mentioned in a previous letter, by His grace and your generosity, all anticipated expenses for this ministry and trip have already been provided! Any funds received in access of actual expenses will be used to meet the greatest needs at that time for Kingdom ministry in Ethiopia and/or Kenya.

Without your prayer and financial partnership, this important ministry would not be possible. Thank you for allowing God to work through you for the advancement of His Kingdom here and abroad. I would like to share with you some details that will better inform you about this work we are partnering in and specific prayer needs.

I am scheduled to fly out of Boston, Ma. On Friday October 30st and arrive in Addis-Ababa on Saturday November 1st. It is arranged for me to teach two groups of leaders while in Ethiopia. The first training will be conducted in the town called Debrezeit in which have been selected and called about 20 leaders of churches representing almost all parts and regions of Ethiopia. The second training will be held in Nazareth and will be made up of leaders from that general region.

In addition to the training sessions, I will also be visiting some people, schools, orphanages and goat projects around Welenchity and Nazareth that we have helped to support since 2010.

The next leg of the journey will find me in Nairobi Kenya from Saturday November 7th through Sunday November 15th. While in Nairobi, I will be conducting leadership training sessions for several church and ministry leaders from various locations in Kenya. I hope to learn how we may continue to partner with ongoing ministries in Kenya once I depart. I look forward to how the Lord may develop relationships for us in Kenya as He has already done for us in Ethiopia.

Please pray for the following:

- The process of finalizing documentation and appropriate inoculations.
- The Lord will grant me adequate sleep/rest on the long flights when I can't use a CPAP.
- Safe travel, protection from hazards and persecution of students, translators, their families and churches.
- Miraculous Holy Spirit filling, empowering and enablement for the Lord's harvesters and His harvest.

Finally, many of these servants of Christ are ministering is remote and hostile areas and are presently subjected or potentially subject to intense persecution. Please pray the Lord's strength, provision and protection be continuously upon them.

I thank God and pray His constant blessing upon you all for your faithful and continued partnership, support and encouragement in ministry.
