I thank the Lord as always for your friendship, partnership and support. This is the sixth letter in regards to the upcoming November 11th – December 04th 2021 ministry trip to Ethiopia. In my last newsletter I had requested prayer that the Lord would clear every obstacle preventing my VISA being delivered on time. The prayers have been answered and I have received the VISA needed. Yesterday I received a negative Covid-19 rapid test and I am now waiting for the PCR results via email which are required for international travel, please pray for no complications and a negative result in regard to that.

While it's no secret that Ethiopia can be an unsafe environment and I usually travel there under a level 2 or 3 travel advisory, at this time it will be under a level 4 travel advisory. They are currently in the midst of a civil war and on 11/02/21 a state of emergency was enacted. After much prayerful consideration and communication with my colleague in Ethiopia I am at peace with proceeding as planned. All of the locations that we will conducting trainings are south of the conflict.

Please continue to pray for the following:

- God's perfect will be done on all of earth as it is in Heaven.
- For the safe and unhindered travel and provision for each student and myself.
- God's protection on my and each student's family and church while we are away.
- Keep everyone safe at each location, no disruptions at any of the 6 venues.
- The Lord's financial provision as needed.
- The Lord's continued guidance and blessing in our 2021 missionary efforts to Africa.
- The Lord multiply radical life transformation through our partnerships.
- The fruits of our labors will help to bring stabilization and peace to Ethiopia.
- The Lord be glorified and His people be blessed.
