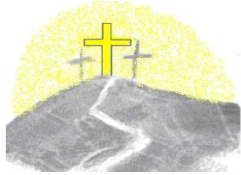

Greetings from Addis Ababa Ethiopia,

Addis Ababa which means "new flower" is the capital and largest city of Ethiopia and has an estimated population of 3,000,000. Addis Ababa is a highly developed and important cultural, artistic, financial and administrative center of Ethiopia. It is widely known as one of Africa's major capitals.



Thank you for your prayers and praise the Lord I arrived safely and in good health, though a bit tired after a 3:00am wakeup and departing from Portland Jetport at 7:00am on Thursday 10/17. I landed in Washington D.C. and then boarded Ethiopian Airlines for a nonstop flight which landed at Bole International Airport in Addis Ababa at 7:00am. After acquiring my VISA upon arrival (my pre-paid E-VISA never came through) so an extra sixty US dollars later and a long wait for my luggage followed by a half hour ride I arrived at my hotel at 10:00am Friday 10/18. Friday and Saturday are primarily rest, recover and preparation days with a brief meeting with Pastor Samson on Saturday. On Sunday 10/20 I will travel 30 miles (approximately one and a half hours southeast by car) to Debre Zeit/Bishtoftu where we will conduct the first training of this tour on Monday 10/21 and Tuesday 10/22. This group will engage in their fifth-round Biblical ecclesiology study entitled What is Church? I am looking forward to and anticipate that this study will lead to a Spirit-led paradigm shift for each participant. From past experiences, I expect this Scripture study will be received with much grateful enthusiasm.
