Dear Brothers and Sisters in Our Lord,

Thank you for the love and support that you have continue show to me and your brothers and sisters in Ethiopia and Kenya by your ongoing prayers and financial support that without this important ministry would not be possible.

At 7:30 this evening I will board the Amtrak to Woburn Ma and then a shuttle to Logan Airport where I am scheduled to depart from at 6 AM Friday October 30<sup>st</sup> and arrive in Addis-Ababa on Saturday November 1<sup>st</sup>, 6:15 AM. It is arranged for me to teach two groups of leaders while in Ethiopia. The first training will be conducted in the town called Debrezeit in which have been selected and called about 20 leaders of churches representing almost all parts and regions of Ethiopia. The second training will be held in Nazareth and will be made up of leaders from that general region. In addition to the training sessions, I will also be visiting some people, schools, orphanages and goat projects around Welenchity and Nazareth that we have helped to support since 2010.

The next leg of the journey will find me in Nairobi Kenya from Saturday November 7<sup>th</sup> through Sunday November 15<sup>th</sup>. While in Nairobi, I will be conducting leadership training sessions for several church and ministry leaders from various locations in Kenya. I hope to learn how we may continue to partner with ongoing ministries in Kenya once I depart. I look forward to how the Lord may develop relationships for us in Kenya as He has already done for us in Ethiopia.

Please continue to pray for the following:

- The Lord will grant me adequate sleep/rest on the long flights when I can't use a CPAP.
- Safe travel, protection from hazards and persecution of students, translators, their families and churches.
- Miraculous Holy Spirit filling, empowering and enablement for the Lord's harvesters and His harvest.
- The Lord's strength, provision and protection be continuously upon these servants of Christ who are ministering is remote and hostile areas and are presently subjected or potentially subject to intense persecution.

I thank God and pray His constant blessing upon you all for your faithful and continued partnership, support and encouragement in ministry.
