Hers is the latest report from Pastor Sami in Ethiopia,

Just a few weeks ago; God has given us a great harvest again and we were able to baptize another 800 people in Lake Kuriftu in the town of Bishoftu, Ethiopia. What a great joy to see those precious souls receiving the Gospel of the Kingdom, repent and accept Jesus Christ as their personal Savior and getting into the lake to be baptized. Those people have walked from 15km / 9.3 miles – 20km / 12.5 miles to reach their designated spot and we have transported them by buses to get them to the Lake in Bisfhotu from those spots.

Our leaders are highly devoted to teaching and lead them to the way of the Lord to be Jesus's true disciples. This is the result of our Disciple – making movements in Jesus's way that we are doing across the country.

Thank you so much for all your prayers and support to help the Gospel to be spread to the most unreached people groups in Ethiopia and beyond.

Upcoming Mission Trip:

A return trip to Ethiopia is planned from October 16th through November 10th. While there I will conduct follow-up visits and next step training to the seven existing groups. Each of these groups are located in different strategic regions throughout Ethiopia and engage in a series of progressive exegetical Biblical studies designed to teach, implement and maintain Biblical Missiology, Biblical Ecclesiology and Biblical Spiritual Formation as taught by Master Jesus, His Apostles/disciples and the early church leaders.
