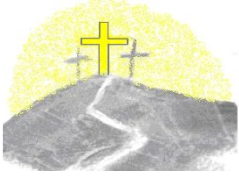

Hello from Nazret/Adama Ethiopia,

Adama, also known as Nazret, population: 324,000 (2015) is a key city in Ethiopia's Rift Valley on the main rail & road route to the port of Djibouti. It is majority Muslim, but Evangelicals are boldly planting churches there. Believers in Adama are in danger from the expansion and teaching of both Islam and Prosperity Preaching. Their shepherds need Biblical understanding, hermeneutical wisdom, and skill in expository preaching of the word of God in order to equip the saints to defend themselves from such error and to proclaim the truth to others. That's why the Lord has placed us (TMMI) since 2015.
