It is nice to be back in the general and familiar area in which Daisy and I grew up and lived in for many years. We are praising God for His leading us to and providing us with these comfortable and affordable living arrangements which will allow me to have a part time vocation and us to continue full time Ministry, local and abroad.

As I reported in the 01/28/22 newsletter, "After much prayerful consideration, receiving the full support of my wife Daisy as well as my employer, I am at peace about and am planning two trips to Ethiopia in 2022 and into the future as the Lord wills and directs".

Last year the Lord granted us success in increasing the number of leaders trained per year from approximately 75 to 140. This year's challenge is to increase from 1 trip per year to 2 trips per year and from 140 leaders trained to 280 plus leaders trained per year. Year by year God increases the work of His hands that He accomplishes by "working in you, giving you the desire and the power to do what pleases him" (Phi. 2:13).

I am scheduled to be in Ethiopia from Friday June 10<sup>th</sup> through Monday June 27<sup>th</sup>. We plan to meet with the same leaders we worked with in November and December of 2021 in order to advance their training to the next level. We anticipate meeting with 120 plus leaders comprised at 5 different locations in the southern regions. Keep in mind that <u>each</u> leader will multiply the impact of these trainings by passing it on to their own group of leaders and churches. This is how we mimic Master Jesus' strategy for multiplying leaders, churches and His disciple making movement that is still alive and well today.
